

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On October 29, 1992, I granted a stay in the above-captioned proceeding pending resolution of Respondent's appeal to the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit. On October 22, 1993, the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit vacated the District Court's grant of summary judgment to the U.S. Department of Education and remanded with instructions to dismiss because Respondent failed to exhaust its administrative remedies. Career Education, Inc., v. Department of Education, 6 F.3d 817 (D.C. Cir. 1993). To date, Respondent has failed to pursue its appeal in this matter. It is HEREBY ORDERED that the proceeding is DISMISSED.
