 CLARIFICATION OF ORDER

This matter comes before me on a Motion for Reconsideration submitted by the Respondent on December 16, 1994. In that motion, the Respondent requests that I reconsider various orders within my November 29, 1994, decision. I hereby deny the Respondent's motion.

I shall, however, clarify certain orders set forth in my decision. Given the inadvertent overcharge acknowledged by the Office of Student Financial Assistance Programs (SFAP),¹ I order the Respondent to remit \$159,862 to the Department.² As for my second order,³ the tribunal below shall expressly state whether the above monetary liability imposed upon the Respondent for proven departmental violations is based upon the "actual loss" formula. Respondent shall remit the foregoing amount, subject to the tribunal's ruling on remand. All other aspects of my decision shall remain in full force and effect.
