DECISION OF THE SECRETARY


This matter comes before the Secretary on appeal by Respondent, Interactive Learning Systems, of an Initial Decision issued by Administrative Judge Richard F. O'Hair on March 8, 2005. Respondent requests that I reverse the findings of the Initial Decision, and reduce Respondent's liability from \$985,798 to \$1,000.

Upon review of this matter, I find that the Initial Decision properly applies the governing legal standards pertinent to the disputed issues, and that the findings of fact are consistent therewith. Therefore, the assessment of Respondent's liability for \$985,798 is warranted.

ORDER

ACCORDINGLY, the Initial Decision issued by Administrative Judge Richard F. O'Hair on March 8, 2005 is AFFIRMED.
