DECISION OF THE SECRETARY


This matter comes before the Secretary on appeal by Respondent, Vernon's Kansas School of Cosmetology, of an Initial Decision issued by Administrative Judge Richard I. Slippen on January 11, 2006. Respondent requests that I reject the findings of the Initial Decision.

Upon review of this matter, I find that the Initial Decision properly applies the governing legal standards pertinent to the disputed issues, and that the findings of fact are consistent therewith. Therefore, the assessment of Respondent's liability for \$1,616 is warranted.

ORDER

ACCORDINGLY, the Initial Decision issued by Administrative Judge Richard I. Slippen on January 11, 2006 is AFFIRMED.
