DISMISSAL

On May 13, 2009, the office of Federal Student Aid (FSA) filed its brief in response to Respondent's appeal. In doing so, FSA requested that I find that Respondent did not properly effectuate its appeal of the Initial Decision issued by Administrative Judge Richard I. Slippen on March 25, 2009. Judge Slippen ruled that Respondent failed to file a mandatory audit due in 2007. On appeal, counsel for FSA acknowledges that Respondent has now filed its 2007 audit. According to counsel, FSA will review the audit to determine whether the liability upheld by Judge Slippen's decision should be adjusted. As such, there are no issues for this tribunal to resolve. Accordingly, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the above-captioned proceeding is **DISMISSED**.
