Decision of the Secretary

On December 29, 1992, RS Men's Hair Styling, Inc. (RS Men's) filed an appeal to the Secretary of the Initial Decision issued on November 17, 1992, by Administrative Law Judge Allan C. Lewis (ALJ). In its appeal RS Men's relies on an equitable theory of relief asking the Secretary to reweigh evidence originally presented to the Texas Guaranteed Student Loan Corporation.

The Secretary has previously addressed the issue of the appropriate scope of review in a disqualification proceeding.¹ The issues which RS Men's attempt to raise on appeal clearly are outside the appropriate scope of review. Therefore, the Initial Decision of the ALJ is held to be the final decision of the Department.
