**ORDER**

On November 22, 1999, the Office of Student Financial Assistance (SFA) filed a Motion to Dismiss the above captioned proceeding. On October 13, 1999, SFA issued a denial of the institution's application to participate in federal student aid programs. SFA's denial was based upon the school's voluntary relinquishment of its accreditation by the National Accrediting Commission of Cosmetology Art and Science.
